Re: Establishment and Rollout of District CPD Committees

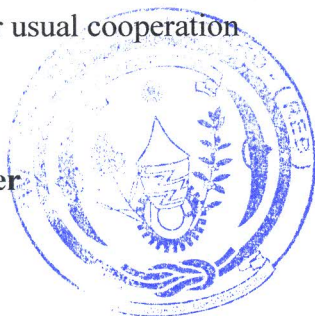
The Government of Rwanda introduced the new national curriculum labeled “Competence-Based Curriculum” in January 2016 in Pre-primary, Primary 1 and 4, and Secondary 1 and 4 across the country. Remarkable nationwide CBC dissemination framework was established to effectively and efficiently conduct School-Based In-Service training (SBI). A well structured cascade training mechanism ensured the CBC training content delivery through National Subject Trainer (NST), District Master Subject Trainer (DMAST) and School Subject Leader (SSL) so that all teachers were able to receive SBI for CBC practice in schools.

However, there is still need for a strong coordination at District level to ensure all Continuous Professional Development (CPD) activities are overseen and yield intended results with maximum efficiency and effectiveness. It is in this regard that the Rwanda Education Board urges all the districts to ensure DCCs are established and engaged in the assigned responsibilities following the timeline on the attached concept note.
